

## Pork prices by Lean Meat Rate (L.M.R.)

**L.M.R. Definition:**

$$\text{L.M.R.} = \frac{\text{muscle rate of four main pieces} + \text{tenderloin}}{\text{carcass weight}} \times 100 \times 1.3$$

Pork prices by L.M.R. are calculated based on a convention defined by the COMITE REGIONAL PORCIN (C.R.P. Regional Pork Committee) and the UNION BRETONNE DES ABATTEURS DE PORCS (U.B.A.P. Union of Pork Slaughterhouse Workers of Brittany)

**1 – Base Price:**

The Pork Market of Brittany (MARCHE DU PORC BRETON) determines base price. 54 L.M.R.

**2 – Weight Range:**

Between 72 and 96 Kg, warm, with no lard, kidney, nor flank (no L.K.F)

**3 – Price difference by L.M.R. point**
